What can I do?

- 1. Make a list of your favorite school courses and extracurricular activities. Why are these your favorites?
- 2. Make a list of 2-3 careers you are interested in. List 5-10 skills you think you would need to be successful at each career.
- 3. Make a picture collage of your ideal learning environment after high school. You can use drawings, cut out images, computer graphics, or other pictures to help visualize your dream school!
- 4. Research colleges, schools, & training centers that have programs to teach you skills and knowledge connected to the careers you were interested in #2. Do they match your ideal learning environment from #3?

Pro Tip!

Research differences between four-year colleges, two-year colleges, vocational technical schools/programs, continuing adult education, and life skills programs.

Go with your family or a trusted member of your transition team to visit two or three colleges, schools or training centers in your community or region that seemed like they could be a good fit for you and your goals.
