Family Information Sharing Activities



What can I do?

1. Encourage your family to ask questions if they are confused and advocate for what you need during the process of your transition planning.
2. Share information with the families of your friends with IEPs. By sharing with other families, you build strong relationships.
3. Ask your friends with IEPs and their families what community resources or programs they participate in. You will gain new knowledge and confidence talking about your plans together.

Pro Tip!

If you are not getting information on programming you need, ask your transition team why this is not happening and who can get the information to you and your family.

How about an ultimate challenge?

With the help of your family, prepare a list of questions you and your family have to ask at your next transition staffing or IEP meeting, such as:

- What skills do I need to learn before graduating from high school?
- What can the school offer me to achieve my goals for after high school?
- What resources are available for me that would benefit me?
