Agencies in Schools



What can I do?

1. Ask your transition coordinator or counselor to help you make a list of the agencies that can help you while you're still in school.
2. What would you like to learn about these different agencies? Make a list!
3. Often, these agencies will provide presentations at your school. Be the first to sign up! It is important to attend these sessions. You will start building your relationships with these agencies while in high school.
4. Talk with your team about what you learn from their presentation. How can the agency help while you are in school? After you complete school?

Pro Tip!

Talk with your team about your future goals. Let them know if you want job shadowing, trips to local colleges, training schools or to organizations in the community.

In order to help you become the super star you are, find ways to follow up with the agency staff you are working with. This will continue to show your leadership skills and show your commitment to learning more!
