Transition Coordinating Council



What can I do?

1. Ask if your community has a Transition Coordinating Council (TCC).
 - If yes, see if you can learn more on the internet.
 - If no, ask why not and how you or your family could help start one.
2. With a trusted adult, make a list of all the people helping you with transition right now. Is anyone on the list on the TCC?
3. If someone from your list is on the TCC, start a conversation with them. Tell them what you think needs to improve about transition in your community.
4. If your community does not have a TCC, talk to people on your list in #2 about starting a TCC in your community.

Pro Tip!

Attend a TCC meeting, listen, and provide suggestions if you have them during any “public comment” time in the meeting. If your community does not have a TCC, be a voice to get one started, and empower your family to join you!

How about an **ultimate** challenge?

If there are youth member positions on your community TCC, apply to be part of your community’s council and be a voice for youth!
