Transition Staffing



What can I do?

1. Meet with your case manager or transition coordinator. Discuss your goals for adulthood. Ask what more can be done to help you reach your goals.
2. Explore new programs in your school. When you find a program you are interested in, ask your transition team to help you enroll.
3. Research local community and state colleges. All have disability resource offices to provide accommodations, and your transition team can connect you to them.
4. Ask your transition team to invite a vocational counselor from the Department of Rehabilitation Services to an upcoming meeting. This person will have access to many resources in your area to prepare you for employment and to support your career development.

Pro Tip!

Lead your next transition meeting and make sure agency staff you know are present. Let them know about your goals, interests and passions.

How about an ultimate challenge?

Before you graduate high school, make a plan to connecting with each agency or college staff you connected with during high school. Follow through on meeting with them and stay in contact.
