## University Partnerships



### What can I do?

1. Design a Pinterest “dream school” board. Pin images, articles, or descriptions of colleges, universities, or training programs that match your vision for the future.
2. Take the [College Board College Survey](#) to narrow down choices of universities and colleges that are a good match for you.
3. Share your Pinterest board or College Board Survey results with your transition team.
4. Ask them what partnerships your school or community agencies have with colleges, training programs, or universities that will connect you to the learning environments that are the best match for you.

### Pro Tip!

Ask your transition team to talk to you and your family about the difference between high school and college, so you know your rights and individual responsibility around accommodations and access.

### How about an ultimate challenge?

Dual enrollment classes (classes at a community or technical college or local university that you take while you are still in high school) can help you develop adult learning skills so you have a smooth transition into these environments after high school.
