## Career Development Classes



### What can I do?

1. With the help of your transition team, take different career assessments to discover your employment preferences and working styles.
2. Talk with your school counselor. Create a schedule of classes that will help you gain skills related to careers that match your interests and working style.
3. Meet with your transition team and discuss which career development classes are ideal for you based on your interests, dreams, and needs.
4. Meet with the instructors of your career development classes to discuss the different supports, accommodations, and services you need to best access and demonstrate mastery in their classes.

### Pro Tip!

Ask your special education case manager to observe your career development classes. Get their feedback on accommodations and supports that could be helpful in those classes, since they can be different from traditional academic classes.

### How about an ultimate challenge?

Talk to your instructors about work-based learning opportunities connected to your career development classes. Ask how you can participate!
