Career Clubs



What can I do?

1. Take the [O*Net Interest Profiler](#) to determine what jobs match your interests. Create a list of 2-5 jobs that interest you the most from the survey results.
2. Do a Google Maps search of businesses near your home or community that align with the jobs you identified in step one.
3. If your school has a career club, join it! If you are already a member, use your survey results to suggest that the club invite two new businesses to present.
4. If your school doesn't have a career club, ask teachers on your transition team if they would like to create a career club. Create a vision board for what the career club will include and the goals of the club.

Pro Tip!

Do a mock interview with your sibling or caregiver! Practice “selling yourself” by explaining why you are a good fit for the jobs you were most interested in.

How about an ultimate challenge?

Create advertisements for other students to join your school's existing or future career club. Include the businesses you are recruiting to come in to present to the club to spark their interest!
