## Postsecondary Education Programs



### What can I do?

1. Before choosing a college, it is a good idea to know what career you are interested in. If you're not sure, check out our Tip Sheet on Career Exploration!
2. Use the [BigFuture website](#) to find the right college for you. Use the filters to narrow your search and find programs that are a good fit.
3. Choose 3-5 programs to learn more about. Visit each college website.
4. Explore the degree that you are interested in. It is important to look at the program requirements, required coursework, and electives.

### Pro Tip!

See if you can print out the degree plan with the entire list of required courses. Share this list with your transition team and talk about what you can do to be prepared.

### How about an ultimate challenge?

Learn more about each college, including living arrangements, activities, and supports for students with disabilities. Work with your transition team or family members to schedule a visit to the programs you like, to see if they are a good fit.
