Postsecondary Career Training Programs



What can I do?

1. Use the [O*Net Interest Profiler](#) to identify a career pathway that is a good match.
2. Click on “Job Zone 3” or “Job Zone 4” to find a list of jobs in that career pathway that require career training. Pick a job from those lists that looks interesting and find out what certifications you need.
3. Find a career training program that meets the job certification requirements. You can use the [My Next Move](#) website. Type in your career and then click “find training” in the Education box.
4. Research the training program to make sure it meets the certification requirements. Find out about cost and the application process.

Build your own graphic organizer or use a template to organize the information you find about different career training programs.

Share the graphic organizer with your transition team. Ask them to help you create short-term or long-term goals to help you get into and finish your chosen career training program.
