### What is included?

This resource can be used as-is or modified to fit your community. Included is a profile for a young person getting ready to graduate and start his independent living journey. There is also a list of monthly expenses, job descriptions/ads and instructions. Work together to help Juan Million map out his future!

Materials:

- Bills above printed and cut
- Envelopes – one for each bill and one for money – label the envelopes with bill
- Fake money – at least \$2500 in different denominations
- 3 real job descriptions from community printed for everyone
- Juan Million's profile

Directions:

1. Review Juan Million's profile together to get to know him.
2. Review the 3 jobs from the community. These should be entry level positions that do not require a degree or post-secondary training.
3. Have participants agree on which job would be best for Juan.
4. Make someone the banker and hand him the amount of money Juan would bring home after deductions for 1 month.
5. Distribute the envelopes with the bills to other participants.
6. Tell a story of Juan paying his bills from above.
7. Ask whoever has each bill to go collect money from banker and put it in their envelopes.
8. At the end, discuss how much money is left over, if any. Talk about which bills are fixed and which are variable. What can Juan change in his life to make sure he has enough money?
